Valid for the exhibition areas of the Deutsches Museum and its branches

Dear visitors, please note:

We take criticism seriously, but are equally pleased to receive your suggestions for improvement and ideas.

- Please follow the instructions of our staff.
- Bulky hand luggage, umbrellas etc. must be left at the cloakroom. Anyone leaving luggage in an abandoned state will be liable to considerable security charges, which the Deutsches Museum will have to pass on to you.
- The use of skateboards, inline skates, city scooters, etc. is not permitted.
- Animals may not be taken into the exhibition areas.
- Except for hands-on experiments, please do not touch exhibits.
- Smoking is not permitted in the rooms. Food and drinks may only be consumed in the designated areas.
- Filming and photography is permitted for private purposes only. Use on the internet is not permitted, nor is the copying of photographs onto digital storage media.
- Unfortunately, the use of a tripod cannot be permitted - if only for safety reasons.
- Guardians such as parents, teachers and other persons must supervise those entrusted to their care in order to prevent accidents and damage.
- For safety reasons, stairs, passages and designated escape routes must be kept clear at all times.
- Visiting hours end at 5.00 p.m.; closing begins at 4.50 p.m. Special areas close a little earlier.
